Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the Bhanwar Lal Nahata Smriti Sansthan's, Mandsaur Institute of Ayurved Education & Research, Mhow – Neemuch Road, Opp.-Krishi Upaj Mandi, Mandsaur, Madhya Pradesh for 50 seats in UG (BAMS) course as well as for issuing Letter of Permission (LOP) to increase the admission capacity in existing UG (BAMS) course from 50 to 100 seats for the current academic session 2018-19 under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 – reg.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No.R-12011/10/2009-EP (IM-1) for 2017-18 dated 04.08.2017 related to admission matter for the year 2017-18 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the 2018-19 session.

2. The CCIM's vide Ref.No.3-5/2017-Ay. (32) dated 01.02.2018 issued Letter of Intent to increase admission capacity from 50 to 100 seats in existing UG (BAMS) course to aforesaid college. Further, The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 05.02.2018 and re-visited on 28-29.05.2018 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining the same, it was observed that required number of Higher faculty in the department of Rog Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan and Swasthavirtha & Yoga, Web based computerized central registration system in OPD/IPD, X-Ray, ECG and USG, Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff and PG students

and required number of Part time teacher were not available as per RMS, 2016. Therefore, under provisions of the first proviso to sub-section (5) of Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on 27.08.2018 to present the case.

- 3. The observation of hearing Committee based on submission made by the college representatives during hearing and recommendations & visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approved Standard Operative Procedures (SOPs) for the UG/PG course(s) for consideration of grant of conditional permission for UG (BAMS) course, it is found that College is fulfilling criterion for granting conditional permission for existing UG (BAMS) course as well as issuing Letter of Permission (LOP) to increase admission capacity in existing UG (BAMS) course from 50 to 100 seats.
- 4. It has therefore, been decided by the Central Government to *grant of conditional* permission to the Bhanwar Lal Nahata Smriti Sansthan's, Mandsaur Institute of Ayurved Education & Research, Mhow Neemuch Road, Opp.-Krishi Upaj Mandi, Mandsaur, Madhya Pradesh with 50 seats in UG (BAMS) course as well as issuing Letter of Permission (LOP) to increase admission capacity in existing UG (BAMS) course from 50 to 100 seats for the academic session 2018-19 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the condition that college shall fulfill the deficiencies as mentioned below by 31st December, 2018:
  - (i) Aadhaar based Geo location enabled attendance system for teaching staff, non-teaching staff, hospital staff as per RMS, 2016.
  - (ii) Functional USG facility in the Hospital.
- 5. In addition, following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2018 to get conditional permission for the session 2019-20:
  - (i) all the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
  - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
  - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*,

- 6. This permission to increase admission capacity from 50 to 100 seats in existing UG course for the first admitted batch of 2018-19 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against the course appear for the first final examination of the said course and at that time, the college authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970.
- 7. The college administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers, as prescribed in the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the students in the above-mentioned increase in admission capacity from 50 to 100 seats in existing UG (BAMS) course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.
- 8. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2019-20.
- 9. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
