Sub: Grant of conditional permission to the “**Bhanwar Lal Nahata Samriti Sansthan, Mandsaur Institute of Ayurved Education & Research, Mandsaur-458001, Madhya Pradesh** with **50 seats** in BAMS (UG) course under Section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 for the academic session 2017-18

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order no. R.12011/10/2009-EP (IM-1) for 2016-17 dated-22.10.2016 related to admission matter for the year 2016-17 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case for the academic session 2017-18.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 19-20.04.2017 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry.

3. The recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the “Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016”, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC) for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2017-18 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/03/2017-EP (IM-1) dated 12.06.2017 (available at Ministry's website <indianmedicine.nic.in>) and it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria as follows:-

- (i) Teachers: For UG course: 100% eligible teachers, minimum 12 Higher Faculties (Professor/Readers) in 11 departments, at least 01 teacher in each of 14 department in the college up to 60 UG seats and 10 Part Time Teachers;
- (ii) Beds in hospital: Minimum 60 beds in hospital of college for UG course up to 60 seats;
- (iii) Minimum 120 patients per day in OPD during the year 2016 for up to 60 UG seats;
- (iv) Minimum 40% bed occupancy for UG College in IPD during the year 2016; and
- (v) Equipment and instruments: Minimum 75% of required equipment/instruments as specified under the schedule VII of RMS/ as per Policy dated 12.06.2017.

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4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to **grant conditional permission** to the **Bhanwar Lal Nahata Samriti Sansthan, Mandsaur Institute of Ayurved Education & Research, Mandsaur-458001, Madhya Pradesh** with **50 seats** in BAMS (UG) course for the academic session 2017-18 under section 13C/13A of the IMCC Act, 1970, subject to the condition that the college shall fulfil the following requirements by 31st December, 2017 which will be verified for granting permission from the academic session 2018-19 onwards:

- (i) all the relevant provisions of the Minimum Standard Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 ;
- (ii) relevant requirements under the (Minimum Standard of Education in Indian Medicine) amendment Regulations of 2016 (for Ayurveda); and
- (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

5. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled by means of an inspection and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2018-19.

6. This issues with the approval of competent authority.
