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1. About University

Mandsaur University (MU) conferred the university status under the M.P. Act No. 17 of 2015 of the Madhya Pradesh Niji Vishwavidyalaya (Sthapna avam Sanchalan) Sanshodhan Adhiniyam, 2015 and is recognized by the UGC under the section 2(f) of UGC Act. 1956. As a full-fledged university, its first academic session began in the year 2016-17. Mandsaur University is also a member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU). Mandsaur University, though in its budding stage, yet it has carved a niche on its own, although it is one of the youngest universities in the Malwa region. Mandsaur University believes in the student centric activities and governed by different student committees. 6. SPANDAN 2K23

SPANDAN 2K23 was not just an ordinary University fest; it was an extraordinary milestone in the history of the university. With the inclusion of a celebrity night and a captivating blend of technical events and cultural activities, it created a buzz of excitement and anticipation like never before. This report takes you on a journey through the meticulous planning, the challenges faced, and the remarkable achievements attained during this ground-breaking event. It serves as a beacon of guidance for future event organizers, inspiring them to aim for greatness and create unforgettable experiences for all.

The planning process for SPANDAN 2K23 began in November 2022, initiated by six students who discovered that the university intended to organize technical and cultural events. They decided to make it the biggest event ever and planned a celebrity night in addition to the technical and cultural events. Mandsaur university



organized a two days techno- cultural fest named as “SPANDAN 2K23” on the 17th & 18th of March 2023.

This multi-disciplinary mega event provided dynamic, diverse, social and cultural environment for the young, creative and innovative minds, aspirants, industrial persons, scientists, researchers, faculty members, school students, to expose their work through various technical, non-technical and cultural events and competitions like hackathon, Robo race, decoding, short film, build from waste, plenary talks, paper presentations, connections (fun event), marketing & selling, poetry writing & recitation, sports and games, dancing, singing and many more.



One of the major attractions of ‘Spandan 2k23’ was the two days National Conference on “Emerging Trends in Science, Technology and Management (NCETSTM2k23)”. Eminent scientists, leading industrialists, distinguished professors from reputed research institutes & laboratories, industries and universities delivered the key note address in conference arena and interacted with the participants. In Spandan 2k23 there were a 6K+ footfall. Spandan consisted of 9 Technical Events mentioned below.

1) Robo Race: - Designed a robot both wired or wireless within the specified dimensions that could operate manually and could travel through all turns of the track.

2) Drone Competition: - Aerial Drone Competition was played on an Arena of 50’x50’ field. Each team had to clear the arena in minimum time limit and end the game by landing on the landing pad (Archery Pad).

3) Electro mania: - Electro mania was the activity/event based on designing of electrical circuits on printed circuit board. Students fabricated the circuit with a specific application within the given time frame.



4) LAN Gaming: - In LAN gaming, local area network (LAN) connection was established between the devices using a router or switch, primarily for the purpose of playing multiplayer video games together.

5) Hackathon: - In Hackathon, coding competition was organized where students from computer science and applications background, tried to solve real world problems and developed a software solution for the same.

6) Popsicle Bridge Competition: - In this event the participants prepared a bridge using Popsicle. After completion of bridge a load applied on the top of the bridge and the load carrying capacity was determined.

7) Biz Fest: - It was a management game of three rounds which was related to identification and recognition of the brands and their products.

8) Ad-mad Show: - The Ad-mad Show competition “where creativity meets madness”, was an opportunity to bring out individual and collective talent of the students who participated in it.

9) Business Plan Competition: - Participants challenged to conceive a novel business (Product, solution, service) idea which can be developed into a commercial startup venture.

A celebrity night by “TOSHI & SHARIB” was organized on 17th of March 2023. There were approximately 2K+ footfall in the celebrity night. A cultural event named as “Abhivyakti” consisted of a Group dance, Poetry, Solo singing & Duet Singing was also organized. There were more sport events such as Ring-A-Bottle, Pyramid Toss, Football Toss, Feed the Clown, Hoopla/Toss the Ring, Spin the Wheel, Take a chance Bulletin & Balloon Pop. Campus Funk consisted of Scavenger (treasure hunt), Kismat Connection, Nimbu relay race, Golgappa Rust, Dance Impromptu, Bare Knuckle (Arm Wrestling), Dumb Charades, Reverse Clash (Tug of War), Beg borrow steal, Muscle Battle (Push up Challenge), Satoliya, Guess the Phrase & Chess. There were 450 plus students & Faculty members who actively participated in the games. There were also an EDA (equipment display area), Auto Expo & Project Expo in which the 13 shops, Ridhi Sidhi Event, Mahindra, Tata, Royal optical, Rajputi Poshak, Thunder X, Jaya Herbal, Santosh Associates, Goma Bai Eye hospital, Science on Wheels, Rig Anthony, Lenovo & Kinetic Green) along with the 15 Departments (Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Electrical & Electronic Engineering, Computer Science & Application, Ayurveda, Agriculture, Nursing, Pharmacy, B.Ed, Life Science, BA [JMC, Fashion Design & Tourism] & DBMC) displayed their equipment in the stalls.

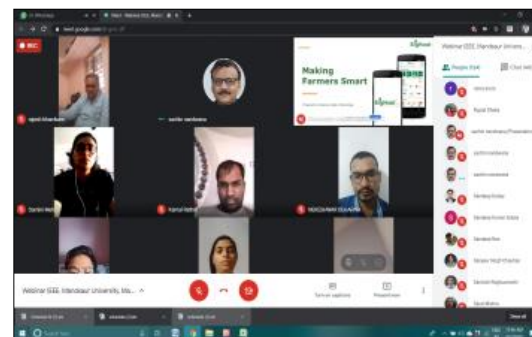

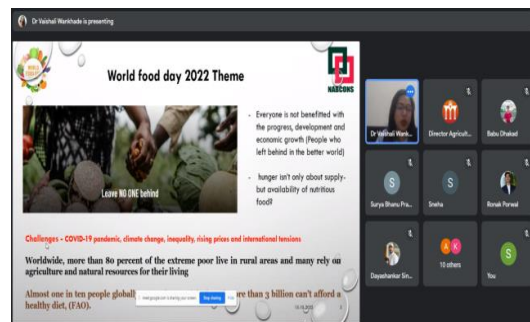
- International Webinar on “Guide to Good Dairy Farming Practice:**

10. Club Activities

• Social awareness and environment sustenance Club

- **Awareness program on Lumpy skin disease:** - In view of National Foundation Day of NSS (24.09.2022), the Social Awareness & Environment Sustenance Club (NSS Unit) of Mandsaur University had organized an “Awareness program on Lumpy skin disease of cattle” at the adopted village-Guradiya Deda on 30.09.2022. This disease is caused by the lumpy skin disease virus (LSDV) and is a vector-borne pox disease of domestic cattle and Asian water buffalo. At present, it is affecting cattle severely in the Rajasthan and Madhya Pradesh states of India.



The main objective of this awareness program was to spread awareness among the village peoples regarding lumpy virus. In the beginning, the NSS volunteers have interacted with the Sarpanch and Up-Sarpanch of Guradiya Deda. They enthusiastically started the rally chanting slogans related to cow's importance and protection from Lumpy virus, had door to door interaction with the local peoples, informed about the common symptoms, preventive measures and distributed pamphlet related to primary home remedies of lumpy skin disease.

Few volunteers among them carried out a survey of LSD cases and found infected cows with visual symptoms. They provided all the possible information related to LSD to the villagers. A random question-based survey was also conducted by volunteers to know about the awareness among the villagers about the disease. At the end of the program, the effort of NSS volunteers on the current issues were appreciated by the Brig. (Dr.) Bharat Singh Rawat, Vice Chancellor, Mandsaur University, Mandsaur and motivated for the societal development.

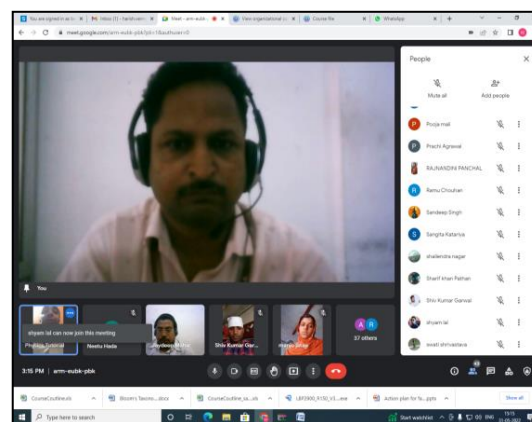



The list is available at the UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.

The University is empowered to award degrees as specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act through its main campus in regular mode with the approval of Statutory Bodies of the University and Statutory Council(s) wherever required. However, universities can award only such degrees as specified by UGC after creation of required academic and physical infrastructure facilities, including library, laboratories and appointment of teaching and supporting staff as per the norms and standards laid down by the UGC and Statutory Council(s) concerned.

The University is required to follow the UGC Notification on Specification of Degrees 2014 and its amendments issued from time to time wherein consolidated list of UGC approved nomenclature of degrees has been specified under Section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956 wherein entry level of each degree and duration of programme have been provided. The approved nomenclature may be followed by the specific area of specialization to be reflected in the parentheses.
