Eligible candidates need to appear for the entrance test and personal interview for the admission in Ph. D program. Exemption from the entrance test is applicable as per the guidelines of the regulatory bodies and their amendments notified time to time.

EXAM FEE:

Rs. 1000/- (One Thousand only)

ELIGIBILITY:

Eligibility criteria for admission to the Ph.D. Programme.-The following are eligible to seek admission to the Ph.D. programme (as per UGC regulation 2022 Dated 07 November 2022):

(1) Candidates who have completed: A 1-year/2-semester master's degree programme after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme or a 2-year/4-semester master's degree programme after a 3-year bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.

A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

(2) Candidates who have completed the M.Phil. Programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme. A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

PROCEDURE:

- All candidates must fill the application form as prescribed.
- Along with the application form candidate has to submit one page abstract of the proposed research work (Proposed title, a short back ground of the work, Short objective and outcomes.
- For personal interview, candidate has to present his / her proposed research work (Maximum 4 slides) as per the following guidelines.
 - a. First slide : candidate and department name
 - b. Second slide : Title of the proposed Ph.D work with short back ground
 - c. Third slide : Short objectives
 - d. Fourth slide : Expected outcomes (No of journal papers publication, conference paper presentation, No of patent or technology transfer, Any other)
- Candidate needs to submit his / her self-assisted copies of related documents before the personal interview.
