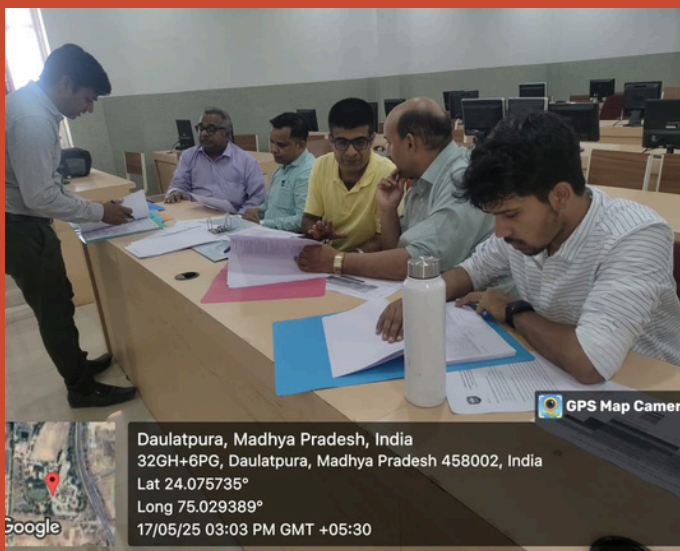
PhD Pre Thesis Viva
