## 5.2 National Conferences/Workshops/Seminar Organized

### ○ National Symposium & Conference on Challenges & Opportunities of Artificial

**Intelligence in Pharmacy:** The National Symposium and Conference on “Challenges and Opportunities of Artificial Intelligence in Pharmacy” was successfully organized at B.R. Nahata College of Pharmacy in collaboration with APTI MP State on March 28–29, 2025. The event brought together over 400 participants, including experts, researchers, academicians, and students, to explore the evolving role of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in the pharmaceutical sector.

Wonder Cement Ltd. sponsored the seminar as part of the celebrations for Engineers Day on September 15, commemorating the birth anniversary of Sir Mokshagundam Vishveshwaraya.



The primary objective of the seminar was to familiarize students with the ongoing revolution in next-generation manufacturing, particularly in the cement industry, which is increasingly adopting Industry 4.0 technologies such as the Internet of Things (IoT), robotics, and artificial intelligence. The seminar provided a comprehensive overview of the cement manufacturing process—from quarrying and crushing to final packaging—while highlighting the integration of advanced technologies at each stage. Expert speakers elaborated on critical areas such as process optimization, diagnostic studies, troubleshooting, and the transformation of conventional operations into intelligent systems.

Topics covered included real-time monitoring through IoT, big data analytics, digital twins, and cybersecurity, all of which are driving productivity and operational efficiency in the sector. The seminar also shed light on emerging career opportunities for students as cement technologists, in light of the rapid growth of the Indian cement industry and increasing global demand. Participants gained valuable insights into goal-setting, skill enhancement, and the alignment of academic knowledge with practical industry applications. A total of 148 participants attended the seminar, which successfully raised awareness and inspired future

engineers to embrace technological advancements in industrial domains.

○ **National Workshop on Use of Geo-Information System and Remote Sensing in**

**Agriculture for Precision Farming:** The One-Day National Workshop on “Use of Geo-Information System and Remote Sensing in Agriculture for Precision Farming” was organized on 1st October by the Faculty of Agriculture Sciences, Mandsaur University. The workshop featured resource persons Er. Mukesh Gupta, IT Officer, M.P. Govt., GTPC, Jaora, and Er. Rahul Mittal, RPC (Drone



Pilot License Holder) and Agri-Tech Entrepreneur, Ratlam. The program aimed to impart knowledge on the fundamental concepts of remote sensing, aerial photography, and imagery interpretation, with a special focus on applications in agriculture, including soil analysis, plant health monitoring, and yield forecasting. Participants learned about the integration of Geographic Information Systems (GIS) and remote sensing for precision farming, approaches to data collection, and the use of drones in agricultural monitoring. Hands-on sessions were conducted on GIS software, drone operations, GPS handling, spatial data creation, and editing, enabling students to gain practical exposure alongside theoretical understanding. The workshop was inaugurated by Hon’ble Vice Chancellor Prof. (Dr.) V.S.S. Kumar, who delivered a motivational address encouraging students to adopt advanced technologies for agricultural development. The event was successfully coordinated by Prof. (Dr.) Dinesh Baboo Tyagi, Prof. (Dr.) Kundan Singh, Dr. R. P. Srivastava, Dr. Ravi Ranjan Saxsena, Dr. Ajay Kumar Jaiswal, and other faculty members of the Faculty of Agriculture Sciences. A total of 51 internal participants attended, gaining skills in GPS operation, data generation, image interpretation, and GIS-based analysis, which are vital for modern precision farming practices.

○ **National Workshop on Digital Forensics and Cyber Security:**

The Department of Forensic Science, Mandsaur University, organized a Two-Day National Workshop on Digital Forensics and Cyber Security from 20- 21 September 2024, in observance of World Forensics Day. The event was inaugurated by Hon’ble Vice Chancellor Prof. V.S.S. Kumar, IQAC Coordinator Dr. Shekhar Jain, and Head of the Department



Dr. Ravshish Kaur Kohli, along with faculty members and guest speakers Mr. Gaurav Jha (Digital Forensic Analyst) and Mr. Gaurav Panwar. The ceremony commenced with Sarasvati Vandana and lamp lighting, followed by addresses emphasizing the significance of digital forensics in addressing contemporary cyber threats.

Day one covered topics such as networking protocols, Linux essentials, ethical hacking, Kali

Linux, and cloud and endpoint security. Day two focused on digital forensic tools including FTK Imager, EnCase, and Magnet Axiom, alongside data analytics, evidence handling, and real-world case simulations. A quiz competition further evaluated participants' understanding. The sessions integrated theoretical knowledge with extensive hands-on training, allowing students to work on simulated forensic scenarios and enhance decision-making skills. The workshop concluded with a valedictory session honouring guest speakers and distributing certificates to all 76 student participants and 4 faculty members from the Departments of Forensic Science and Computer Applications. The event significantly enhanced participants' competencies in digital investigation and cyber security.

- **National Workshop on Fact Checking and Media Literacy:** The Department of Journalism and Mass Communication, Mandsaur University, organized a National Workshop on “*Fact Checking and Media Literacy*” on 27 September 2024. 12th-grade students, undergraduates, postgraduates, research scholars, and faculty members attended the event.



Mr. Pravin Dubey, Editor-in-Chief of BSTV (Madhya Pradesh & Chhattisgarh), served as the resource person, addressing the growing challenge of misinformation in the digital era. The workshop aimed to strengthen participants' media literacy, critical thinking, and fact-checking skills. Key topics included media types, identifying bias and propaganda, evaluating source credibility, and understanding media manipulation. Participants were trained in fact-checking techniques such as image and video verification, use of reliable databases, and digital tools for authenticity assessment. Ethical journalism practices—especially concerning fake news and the speed-versus-accuracy dilemma—were also discussed.

Interactive exercises using real-world case studies were a highlight, receiving positive feedback. Participants recommended longer practical sessions and more focus on social media-related misinformation. The workshop concluded with suggestions to hold regular follow-up sessions, incorporate media literacy into academic curricula, develop an online resource hub, and collaborate with local media outlets for applied learning. The initiative successfully enhanced participants' ability to critically assess media content and strengthened awareness of ethical practices in journalism.

- **National workshop on Java Programming:** The Department of Computer Science Applications (CSA), Mandsaur University, organized a Five-Day National Workshop on “Java Programming” from 14-19 October 2024 for BCA for III semester students. Mr. Uday Kumar Konchada from Indeed Inspiring Infotech, Pune, Maharashtra conducted the sessions. Designed for both beginners and those with prior programming knowledge, the workshop aimed to strengthen participants' understanding of core Java concepts through practical, hands-on training. Day 1 introduced Java fundamentals, control structures, and functions. Day 2 focused on object-oriented programming, followed by sessions on the String class, access/non-access modifiers, and interfaces on Day 3. Day 4 covered exception handling and

multithreading, while the final day explored advanced topics and included project work. Mr. Uday's interactive teaching style and practical approach fostered a collaborative learning environment. Participants engaged in real-world examples and coding exercises, enhancing their ability to write, execute, and debug Java programs effectively.



Comprehensive supporting materials—including a workshop manual, sample programs, exercises, and access to online resources—were provided. The workshop concluded with a wrap-up and Q&A session to reinforce key concepts and guide continued learning. With 90 internal participants, the workshop successfully for future pursuits.

○ **National Workshop on Networking Essentials:**

The Department of Computer Science & Applications, Mandsaur University, conducted a Five-Day National Workshop on “Networking Essentials” from 11 to 16 November 2024 for first-semester students from BCA (CC) and BCA (SACS). The sessions were led by Mr. Venu Babu Maredu and aimed to build a strong



foundation in computer networking through a combination of theoretical learning and practical application. Students, faculty, and IT staff, who actively participated in interactive discussions and hands-on activities, attended the workshop. Key topics included networking fundamentals, models and standards, network configuration, simulation, IP addressing, and sub netting. Participants also worked with real networking devices and tools, gaining valuable experience in hardware and software used in the industry.

Practical sessions focused on network setup, troubleshooting, and maintenance, enhancing participants’ technical proficiency and problem-solving skills. By the end of the workshop, attendees had developed confidence in designing, configuring, and managing basic network infrastructures. With 60 participants, the workshop effectively bridged the gap between theory and practice, equipping learners with essential skills for academic advancement and future careers in networking and IT.

○ **National workshop on “Molecular Diagnostics for Pathogenic Bacteria (MDPB 2024):**

The Faculty of Life Sciences, Mandsaur University, organized a National Workshop on “Molecular Diagnostics for Pathogenic Bacteria (MDPB 2024)” on 28 September 2024 for B.Sc. (Hons) and M.Sc. Biotechnology/Microbiology students. The workshop aimed to familiarize participants with PCR techniques for molecular detection of pathogenic bacteria, along with good laboratory practices, culture media preparation, and bacterial isolation methods. The event commenced with Saraswati Vandana and a welcome address by Mr. Yogendra Kumar Verma, Assistant Professor and Head of the Faculty, who introduced the resource person, Dr. Hardik Pathak, Professor, Department of Biotechnology, JECRC

University, Jaipur. Dr. Pathak also highlighted career opportunities in Biotechnology and Microbiology.

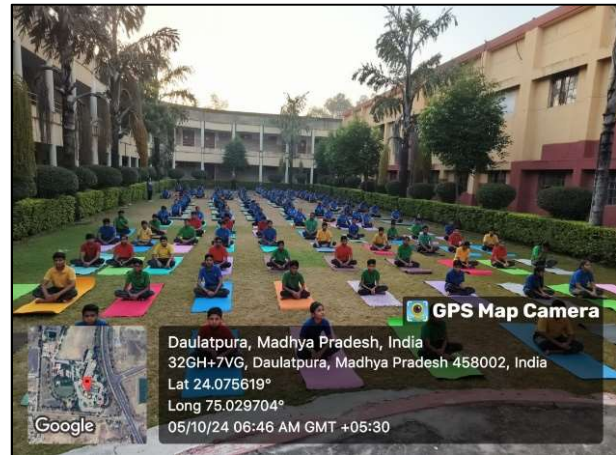
Sessions included presentations by Mr. Ankit Rai on Good Laboratory Practices (GLP) and culture media preparation; followed by hands-on laboratory training in media preparation, pour plate, serial dilution, and streaking techniques. Participants gained experience operating key instruments such as the autoclave, laminar airflow, and hot air oven. Mr. Rai, followed by practical training in DNA isolation, gel preparation, PCR execution, and gel documentation, gave a detailed presentation on PCR.



Students performed critical steps, including setting PCR programs. An interactive Q&A session with Dr. Pathak enhanced understanding of the subject. The workshop concluded with a vote of thanks by Ms. Mansi Prajapati. With 53 internal participants, the workshop successfully combined theoretical knowledge and practical skills, equipping students with essential expertise in molecular diagnostics and pathogen detection.

o **National Workshop on “Yoga Practice and Meditation”**:

The Mandasaur Institute of Physical Education, Mandasaur University, organized a Two-Day National Workshop on “Yoga Practice and Meditation” on 4-5 October 2024. The workshop saw active participation from 180 students of Mandasaur University and MIS, aiming to promote the holistic benefits of yoga and meditation for physical, mental, and emotional well-being. Conducted under the guidance of Dr. Shamsher Singh,



Principal, the event was coordinated by Dr. Surendra Singh Agraiya, with Dr. Rohit Sharma serving as Organizing Secretary, and Dr. Najmuddin Khan and Dr. Himanshu Saxena as Co- Coordinators.

The inaugural session began with a welcome address by Dr. Arunava Das, Dean of Academic Affairs, and the introduction of Chief Guest Dr. Reeta Sharma, Associate Professor. Dr. Rohit Sharma extended gratitude to all guests and participants in his welcome speech. The workshop featured guided sessions in yoga and meditation, emphasizing physical benefits such as improved flexibility, posture, respiratory health, energy levels, and pain management. Additionally, mental and emotional aspects were explored, including stress reduction, increased focus, and enhanced concentration. By the end of the workshop, participants had developed practical skills and a deeper understanding of integrating yoga and meditation into daily routines for overall well-being. The event successfully highlighted the relevance of these ancient practices in supporting modern physical fitness and mental health.

- **National workshop on “Web Application Penetration Testing”:** The Faculty of Computer Science and Applications, Mandsaur University, organized a six-day national workshop on Web Application Penetration Testing from 3-8 March 2025 for UG students. An expert on this field named Mr. Karan Sahu from Bhopal conducted the workshop. The workshop aimed to provide participants with hands-on experience in identifying and mitigating security vulnerabilities in web applications using industry-standard penetration testing methodologies. The program introduced the fundamentals of cybersecurity, ethical hacking, and penetration testing, focusing on OWASP Top 10 vulnerabilities, including SQL Injection, Cross-Site Scripting (XSS), Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF), Broken Authentication, and Security Misconfigurations. Participants learned how attackers exploit such weaknesses and how to implement preventive measures. Tools such as Kali Linux, Burp Suite, OWASP ZAP, and Metasploit were used extensively during practical sessions. Each day focused on specific areas—reconnaissance and information gathering through Google Dorking, WHOIS, and subdomain enumeration; web application scanning and vulnerability assessment; exploitation of OWASP Top 10 vulnerabilities; authentication and session management testing; and best practices for securing applications. Participants also engaged in Capture-the-Flag (CTF) challenges, simulating real-world penetration testing scenarios.



The workshop combined theoretical sessions with extensive hands-on practice, enhancing participants’ understanding of web application security and their ability to use penetration testing tools effectively. Live demonstrations and interactive troubleshooting addressed challenges in comprehending complex attack vectors. With 22 participants, the workshop successfully equipped attendees with practical cybersecurity skills, preparing them for academic and professional growth in ethical hacking, penetration testing, and application security.

- **National Workshop on “Linux Operating System:** The Faculty of Computer Science and Applications, Mandsaur University, organized a National Workshop on “Linux Operating System” from 27 February -5 March 2025, targeting undergraduate and postgraduate students. The workshop was conducted by Mr. Kuldeep Verma, Cyber Security Expert from Satna, Madhya Pradesh, and focused on Linux security, system administration, and penetration testing. Designed to provide an in-depth, hands-on learning experience, the six-day workshop began with Linux architecture, user and permission management, and file system security.



Advanced sessions included reconnaissance-using Nmap, vulnerability assessment with OpenVAS and Lynis, and exploitation techniques such as privilege escalation and service exploitation using Metasploit.

Participants also explored authentication and session management testing, including password cracking, SSH analysis, and securing remote access. The final day covered system hardening, patch management, intrusion detection, and secure logging, concluding with best practices for maintaining a secure Linux environment.

Interactive Capture-the-Flag (CTF) challenges allowed participants to apply their knowledge in real-world scenarios, reinforcing both conceptual and practical skills. The workshop emphasized the integration of theoretical knowledge with hands-on application, enabling participants to develop competency in Linux system configuration, vulnerability analysis, and cybersecurity implementation. With 48 participants, the workshop effectively bridged academic learning and industry-relevant practice, enhancing attendees' proficiency in Linux administration and security.

○ **National Voter Day Celebration 2025:**

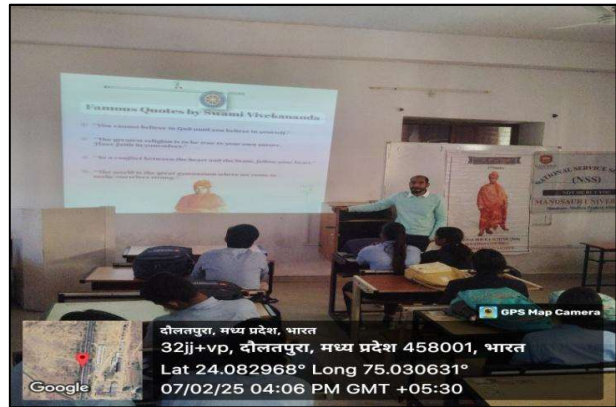


